CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN MULHOLLAND

of Route 1, Gaston, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18150 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 16, 1948 for 0.50 c.f.s., and April 19, 1948 for 1.223 c.f.s.; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.723 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59, Section 31; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59, Section 32, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. When in the distribution of water it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the applicant or his successor in interest will be required to install these so as not to restrict the natural channel of the stream or interfere with the flow of the water therein. The locations and plans of these structures shall be approved by the State Engineer prior to construction.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59
2.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59
5.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59
32.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59
18.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59
1.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59

24.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59

1.0 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on A. Hinman D.L.C. No. 59

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at a stone on the W. line of said DIC No. 59, distant S. 7.87 chains from the NW cor. of said DIC, running thence N. 71 $\frac{1}{4}$ $^{\circ}$ E. 2.86 chs. to angle 1 in road No. 165, thence S. 51 and 3/4 $^{\circ}$ E. 0.54 chs. to an iron bar 18 in. long, thence N. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ $^{\circ}$ E. 6.50 chs. to N. line of said DIC, 11.20 chs. S. 58 $^{\circ}$ E. from the NW cor. of said DIC; thence S. 58 $^{\circ}$ E. 54.30 chs., thence S. 32 $^{\circ}$ W. 75.90 chains to S. line of said DIC. No. 60, thence N. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ $^{\circ}$ W. on such S. line 17.00 chains to the SW corner of said DIC No. 60, thence N. on said W. line of said DIC, No. 60 and No. 59, 88.48 chains to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
