CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL J. SANDE

of Star Route, Forest Grove, , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Gregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Galos Greek

a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17960 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 17, 194?

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.233 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4^{-1} NE $_4^{-1}$, as projected on A. Knighton D.L.C. No. 46, Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, N. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

.u acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected on David Allen D.L.C. No. 47 7.4 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected on A. Knighton D.L.C. No. 46 Section 34

10.8 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected on A. Knighton D.L.C. No. 46 Section 35

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at a point 20.10 chs. W. from a post on the E. line of the DIC of Ammon Knighten in Sec. 35, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., 41.95 chs. from the SE cor. of the said claim, which point is the SW cor. of that portion of said land claim sold to H. Buxton, Jr., as described in deed from R. M. Paintor and wife to Henry Buxton, Jr., dated August 20, 1864, and recorded in Book E. of Deeds, Page 178; and from this beginning point running thence N. 0° 45' E. 680 ft., thence S. 68° 34' W. 1036 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 1° 26' W. 28 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 88° 34' W. 10 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 1° 26' E. 38 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 88° 34' W. 500 ft., more or less to the middle of the channel of Gales Greek; thence following the middle of the channel of said creek with all its meanderings to a point N. 89° 57' W. from the place of beginning; thence S. 89° 57' E. 1211.4 ft. more or less, to the place of beginning, save and except a right of way 12 ft. wide leading from this tract of land through other lands in a northerly direction along the line of Thurston Buxton's land to the county road as bequeathed by the Will of M. E. Dilley filed for probate August 22, 1913.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
