CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **GEORGE HERMAN**

of Route 2, Box 179, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18220 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 9, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.17 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Beal D.L.C. No. 64, Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

33.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Beal D.L.C. No. 64
 20.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Beal D.L.C. No. 64
 35.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Beal D.L.C. No. 64
 3.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Beal D.L.C. No. 64
 Section 28
 Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at the NW cor. of Sec. 28, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M., Washington County, Oregon; thence S. on the sec. line 38.54 chs. to the N. line of Ulysses Jackson land; thence E. on said N. line 21.64 chs. to a post; thence N. 23.52 chs. to a stone; thence E. 11.19 chs. to a post; thence N. 15.30 chs. to a post on the N. line of said Sec. 28; thence W. along the section line 33.03 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 100 acres.

EXCEPTING therefrom the following described 6.0 acre tract: Beg. at the NW cor. of Sec. 28, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M., and running thence E. 89° 26' E. along the N. line of said Sec. 28 a distance of 426.4 feet to an iron; thence S. 1° 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' E. parallel with the W. line of said Sec. 28 a distance of 625.9 ft. to an iron; thence N. 87° 06' W. 427.7 ft. to a point on the W. line of said Sec. 28; thence N. 1° 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. 600.0 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 6.00 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
