CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY J. VANDOMELEN

of Route 5, Hillspore , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualstin River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 1629? of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from key 7, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.323 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEA SWA, Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightioth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres in Lot 5 (SWA NEA)
6.0 acres in SEA NWA
18.4 acres in NEA SWA
0.1 acre in SEA SWA
0.1 acre in Lot 6 (NWA SEA)

Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M. Iand on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

W. 20 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe on the Northerly bank of the Tualatin River at a point on the Easterly line of that cartain tract of land conveyed to August Sahfeld by deed as recorded on page 300 of Vol. 11. deed records of Washington County, Oregon, thence Northwesterly along the E. line of the said tract of land conveyed to August Sahfeld 2699.7 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe at the NE cor. of said tract of land conveyed to August Sahfeld, and at the SE cor. of that certain tract of land conveyed to Peter Herman by deed as recorded on page 600 of Vol. 91, Deed Records of Washington County, Oregon, thence N. 1° 51. E. on Easterly line of said Peter Herman tract 178.2 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
