CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES L. HENDERSON

of Box 221, Wallowa, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a swamp a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17202 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 13, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 1 North, Range 42 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second ~~per acre~~ a diversion of not to exceed 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period from May 1st to July 1st and thereafter shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season ending October 1st,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
Township 1 North, Range 42 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Eleven, township one North, Range Forty-two, East of the Willamette Meridian in Oregon, Running thence south along the West line, of the said Southwest quarter of the southwest quarter; of Section Eleven a distance of Twenty Five Rods; Thence in an Easterly direction a distance of three hundred twenty-five Feet; thence North Twenty-Five Rods; Thence west three hundred twenty feet to the point of beginning, containing three and Twenty-five one hundredth acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
