CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. B. LEDER

of Route 2, Box 277, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Zollner Creek a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17613 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 17, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.216 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
11.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33

Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: That portion of the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section 33, Township 5 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon, particularly described as follows: beginning at a point 11.16 chains West of the East quarter section corner of said Section 33, which place of beginning is also the Southwest corner of 7.58 acres of land conveyed to Anders Halvorson by Deed dated April 21, 1894 and recorded June 30, 1894 in Volume 57 Page 511 in Marion County Deed records, running thence west on the South line of the Northeast quarter of Section 33, 1378 chains, more or less to an iron bar; thence North 20.01 chains; thence East 16.957 chains to a point in the West line of a lane; thence South 9 degrees 53' East 3.875 chains; thence South 31 degrees 50' West 7.32 chains to a point 10.00 chains due North of the place of beginning, thence South 10.00 chains to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
