CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That ELIZABETH V. REASE of Walla Walla State of Washington has a right to the ~~XXXXXX~~ storage of water in Paulina Lake Reservoir located in T. 21 S.R. 12 E. W. M., and the diversion thereof

for the purpose of supplemental supply for the irrigation of 34 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at pages 612-615 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed the storage of 256 acre feet each year, and the diversion of an amount which, together with the amount heretofore granted for the same lands, shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: One-half acre in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; twelve acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; fourteen acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and seven and one-half acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine, Township Twenty-one South, Range Eleven East of Willamette Meridian, in Deschutes County, Oregon.

(Attention is called to certificate issued Nov. 29, 1911, recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 1, Page 11, covering the above lands.)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
