of The Dalles State of Oregon has a right to the negative storage of water in Paulina Lake, located in T. 21 S. R. 12 E. W. M., and the diversion thereof

for the purpose of supplemental supply for the irrigation of 94.5 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume B, at pages 612-615, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed the storage of 710 acre feet each year, and the diversion of an amount which, together with the amount heretofore granted for the same lands, shall not exceed 1.75 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Twenty-one acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; thirty-six and one-half acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and seventeen acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Twenty-one South, Range Eleven East of Willamette Meridian, in Deschutes County, Oregon.
