CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HERMAN EGGER

of Route 2, Hillsboro , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

an unnamed stream a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. under Permit No. 18533 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of scil waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of sold waters confirmed dates from November 1, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.188 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the ST SE, Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, W. 'I.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 5.2 acres in NW SE 9.8 acres in SWA SEA Section 1 Township 2 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by

applicant as follows: The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 1, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W.M., excepting therefrom 1.5 acres, more or less, deeded to John Carpenter, as described in Book K, page 208 of Doed Records of Washington County, Oregon.

ALSO: The SE4 SW4, except the W 28 rods thereof, in Sec. 1, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M., containing 114.50 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
