CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. G. GILL

of Route 4, Box 96, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18736 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.2 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11

Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at the SW cor. of the Thomas Hart DIC in Section 11, T1S, R3W, W.M., running thence S 39.0 rods; thence E to the center of the Tualatin R., thence easterly along the center of said River to the E. line of said section; thence N. along said E. line to a point 15.0 chs. north of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section; thence W. 20.0 chs. and thence S. to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom tract of land conveyed to Wm. M. Hughes and May A. Hughes, his wife, to D. D. Holgate by deed recorded in book 115, page 199, deed records of Washington County, Oregon. ALSO, excepting the following tract:

Beg. at an iron pipe at the SW COR. of the Thomas Hart DIC in Sec. 11, T. 1S, R. 3W, W.M., and running thence N 0°09' W. 991.7 feet to an iron pipe at the NW cor. of that certain 40 acre tract of land conveyed to E. G. Gill by Deed recorded in book 215, page 627 of Washington County, Oregon, deed records; thence N. 89° 57' E. along the centerline of County Road No. 538, a distance of 402.3 feet to a point from which an iron pipe bears S. 0°09' E. 20.0 feet; thence S. 0°09' E. parallel with the W. line of the said Gill tract 1530 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing S. 0°09' E. 50 feet to a point in the center of the Tualatin R., thence upstream in the center of said river S. 71°06' W. 170.3 ft. to a point on the N. line of the Harris property as described on page 5 of Deed Book 206; thence S. 89° 57' W 240.6 ft. to an iron pipe marking the NW cor. of the said Harris tract; thence N. 0°09' W. 643.5 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
