**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **A. E. BROCKWAY**

of **2325 Stewart Avenue, Medford**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **three springs and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-23742, Per. No. R-971** a tributary of **Antelope Creek, tributary of Little Butte Creek,** for the purpose of **irrigation** under Permit No. **18746** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 25, 1949**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **15 gallons per minute, being 4 g.p.m. from east spring, 4 g.p.m. from middle spring, and 7 g.p.m. from west spring,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eighthieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-971, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 15 gallons per minute,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.1 acres in Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
3.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.3 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 18

Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

**N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; S 24 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and Lots 3 and 4 in Section 18 Township 36 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon, Vol. 259, pages 439 and 440, Jackson County Deed Records.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
