 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That EARL BERBER**

of Gales Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Gales Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18883 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Omri Parson D.L.C. No. 37, Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Omri Parson D.L.C. No. 37  
 0.7 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Omri Parson D.L.C. No. 37  
 Section 31  
 Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Parcel No. 1: Beg. at a point on the Township line between T. 2N, R. 4W & T. 2N, R5W, W.M., Washington Co., Ore., N. 0° 03' E 897.2 ft. from the corner of T. 1 & 2 N. & 4 & 5 W., thence N. 0° 03' E. 174.1 ft. to a 4" x 4" cedar stake; thence N. 78° 0° W. 945.5 ft., thence S. 49° 57' W. 69.9 ft. to a point in the center of Gales Creek, thence following down center line of said Gales Creek with meanderings in southerly direction to a point which is N. 6°15' W. 134.3 ft. from an iron in center of county road; thence S. 6°15' E 134.3; thence S. 70° 11' E. 489 ft., thence S. 84° 19' E. 489.3 ft., thence S 60°43' E. 231.5 ft., thence N. 1°02' E. 1221.5 ft., thence N. 89° 37' W. 1433.0 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 44.34 acres.

ALSO

Parcel No. 2: Commencing at an iron pipe, being the NE cor. of the J. A. Thornburg farm located in Sec. 6, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., thence S. to the center of the County Road; thence in a northwesterly direction 200 ft. more or less, to the N. line of said farm; thence SE on said line to the point of beginning, containing 1/2 acre more or less.
