CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ANDREW MILES AND ESTHER H. AUSTIN

of **First National Bank, Forest Grove**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring a tributary of **Carpenter Creek, a tributary of Tualatin R. Watershed** for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ acre garden, under Permit No. **18947** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 22, 1949**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 3**

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

All the following real property situated in the County of Washington, State of Ore., to wit: Beginning at the SW cor. of the Wm. Beagle DIC #38 in T 1 S, R 4 W, W.M., and running thence N. $1^{\circ} 55'$ W. along the W. line of the said DIC 850.0 feet to an iron pipe and thence S. $89^{\circ} 54'$ W. 17.0 feet to an iron pipe and the true place of beg., thence S. $89^{\circ} 54'$ W. along the N. line of Gov. Lot 3; and of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, said township and range, 456.2 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. $5^{\circ} 68'$ W. 527.2 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. $86^{\circ} 56'$ E. 366.06 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. $0^{\circ} 16'$ W. 194.71 feet to an iron pipe and thence N. $22^{\circ} 52'$ E. 379.74 feet to said true place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
