CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That U. G. DAVIS, Wm H. HURLEY AND W. A. STRATTON

of Talent, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Creek, a tributary of Rogue River

BEAR, for the purpose of the irrigation of 280 acres of land

under Permit No. 1072 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 284, on the 10th day of April, 1918; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from February 5, 1912; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 3.50 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Twenty-six acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; twenty-two acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and seven and one-half acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty, Township Thirty-eight South Range One East of Willamette Meridian; Five acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter twenty-two acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; thirty-nine acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; thirty-four acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter thirty-five acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; eighteen acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; sixteen acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; thirty-two acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; seventeen acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and six and one-half acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township Thirty-eight South, Range One West of Willamette Meridian, all in Jackson County. The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the Oregon lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
