CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. M. MIZNER

of Route 1, banks, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19277 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 21, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.228 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 9
Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

beg. at a point on the S line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9, in T 2 N, R 4W, W.M., said beginning point being in the center of County Road No. 177 and bears N. 89° 17' E. 703.1 feet from an iron pipe marking the SW Cor. of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 9, thence S. 60° 58' E. in the center of said road S. 84° 14' E. 319.0 feet; thence continuing in the center of said road S. 77° 48' E. 222.0 feet to a point on the E. line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 9; thence N 0° 26' E. 136.5 feet to the SE cor. of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 9; thence S. 89° 17' W. on the subdivision line 624.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.11 acres.

Beg. at the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9, in T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W.M., and running thence N to the center of dairy creek; thence down said creek to its intersection with the line running N and S through the center of said Sec. 9, thence S to a point 80 rods N. of the center of said Sec. 9; thence W 80 rods to the place of beginning, containing 25 acres more or less.

EXCEPTION therefrom, two parcels heretofore sold to the State of Oregon for highway purposes deeds for which are recorded at Page 271, in book 176, of the deeds records of Washington County, Oregon, EXCEPTING also, tract described in deed recorded in Book 196, page 175, Washington County records. This deed also transfers water right as described in Oregon State permit No. 11768.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
