CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LYLE D. GOODELL

of Route 2, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19529 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.463 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40, Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

24.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40
9.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40
0.4 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40
2.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40
0.6 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Peter Scholls D.L.C. No. 40
Section 10
Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

First Tract: Being a part of the DLC of Peter Scholls and Elizabeth Scholls in Sections 2, 3, 10, 11, in T. 2S, R. 2W, W.M., Washington County, Oregon, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the E line of said DLC of Peter Scholls and wife in T 2 S., R2 W., W.M., which point is N22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 32.92 chs. from the SE cor. of said DLC; thence N 68° W 42.24 chs. more or less to a point in the center of the county road between the lands of Ferdinand Groner and the land now owned by the grantor herein; thence S 17° W. following the center of the said county road 26 chs. more or less to the center of the Tualatin R., thence following down the center of said R. to a point where the center of said river intersects the S line of said Peter Scholls' DLC; thence S 68° E along the S line of said Peter Scholls' DLC 55.90 chains more or less to the SE cor. of said DLC; thence N 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E along the E line of said DLC 32.92 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 134.83 acres more or less.

Second Tract: Being a part of the Z. M. Rowell DLC #45 in Sections 9, 10 and 15 in T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W.M., and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Being that part of said Z. M. Rowell DLC #45 which is in the NE cor. of said claim, and which is N of the Tualatin R., and the N line of said Rowell DLC.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
