CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. J. HEESACKER

of Route 1, Box 355, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek a tributary of Dairy Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19564 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.115 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Lousignout D.L.C. No. 52
1.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Lousignout D.L.C. No. 52
Section 11
1.9 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on John Lousignout D.L.C. No. 52
0.1 acre in Lot 1, (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.2 acre in Lot 2, (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 12

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Being a part of the DLC of John Lousignout and wife, in T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M., and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a cor. of said DLC 7.50 chs. E. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between Secs. 11 and 12, in said T. 1 N., R. 4 W., and running thence W. 52.77 chs. to an iron rod set for corner in center line of County Road No. 33, thence S 26° E. along center line of said road 39.86 chs. to an angle in same; thence S 7° 30' E 3.98 chs. to a stone; thence N 60° 10' E 31.65 chs. to a stone; thence N 76° 30' E 8.04 chs., thence N 21.91 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 136.83 acres of land.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
