**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That A. DONLEY BARNES**

of 701 North Fourth Street, Grants Pass State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Store Gulch a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of mining and domestic use for one family under Permit No. 19608 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.91 cubic foot per second, being 0.90 c.f.s. for mining, and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 3  
Township 38 South, Range 9 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at Post #1, thence N. 600' to corner #2; thence W. 1500' to Cor. #3, thence S. 600' to Cor. #4; thence E. to Cor. #1, claim name Wilson, situated in Sec. 3, Twp. 38 S., R. 9 W., WM, Amended Location Notice of which is recorded in Mining Records of Josephine County, Oregon, in Volume 35, at Page 47.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
