CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. H. ATEN

of Route 1, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed drainage a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19722 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 25, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.213 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on T. Humphrey D.L.C. No. 39, Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on T. Humphrey D.L.C. No. 39
Section 11
12.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on T. Humphrey D.L.C. No. 39
Section 12
Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Commencing 919.5 ft. S. 0° 21' E of the NE Cor. of the Thos D. Humphrey D.L.C. in Sec. 12, T 2 S, R 2 W, W.M., in Wash. County, State of Oregon, thence N. 88° 26' W 1327.6 ft, thence S 35° 15' W 366.3; thence S 88° 26' E 800 ft., thence S 5° 45' W. 691 ft. to the center of the road; thence along the center of said road S 88° 35' E 278 ft; thence N 68° 37' E 232.2 feet; thence N 44° 17' E. 353.2 ft., thence N. 24° 11' E 142.5 ft., thence N. 28° 35' E. 320 ft., thence N 30° 56' W. 271.1 ft. to the place of beginning - 19.96 acres.

ALSO: Part of Thos. D. Humphrey D.L.C. 39 in T. 2 S., R. 2 W., described: Commencing at the S-westerly cor. of tract of land conveyed by investment Co. to John Kennington by deed dated Sept. 3, 1902, page 445, Book 59, records of Wash. County, running S. 35° 51' W. 812.3 ft. to an iron stake, thence N. 88° 35' E. 783.5 ft. to iron stake thence N. 5° 53' E. 692.5 ft. to an iron stake; thence S 88° 26' W. 411.6 ft. to the place of beg.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
