## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That ERNEST HEESACKER

of Route 1, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork of Dairy Creek

a tributary of Dairy Creek irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 19732 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.528 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEZ NWZ, Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.2 acres in Lot 1 (NW4 NW4)
20.2 acres in SW4 NW4
0.6 acre in SE4 NW4
0.4 acre in Lot 4 (NE4 SW4)
4.0 acres in NW4 SW4
Section 13
8.4 acres in SE4 NE4
1.4 acres in NE4 SE4
Section 14
Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at a stone 3.36 chs. S of the \$\frac{1}{2}\$ sec. cor. between Secs. 13 & 11, T. 1 N., R 4 W., W.M., thence N 89°57' E 8.70 chs., thence N 6.33 chs., thence S 89°57' W 20.71 chs. to a stone in the center of the County Road, thence S 43' E along the center of said road 6.33 chs. to a point 30 ft. W. of a stone, thence N. 89°57' E. 11.93 chs., to the place of beginning, containing 13.08 acres of land.

Beg. where the S line of the DIC of John Lousignout crosses the W line of Sec. 13 T. 1 N., R 4 W., W.M., said point being 7.08 chs. S of cor. to sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, running thence E 20 chs. with the S line of said Claim to center of Dairy Creek, thence following the meanderings of said stream down stream to a point on the E line of the NW4 of Sec. 13, said township and range, thence continuing down center of Dairy Cr. with all its meanderings to a point where it crosses center line of Sec. 13, being 1.84 chs. N of center point of said Section; thence S 1.84 chs. to N. of center point of said Section, thence S. 1.84 chs. to center of said Sec., thence S 84°15; W 20.10 chs., thence S 1.36 chs., thence N 89° 30; W 11.23 chs., thence N 6.26 chs., thence N 89° 30; W 8.37 chs. to line between Sections 13 and 14, 2.90 chs. N of \( \frac{1}{4} \) sec. cor., thence N 89°30; W.

12 chs., thence N 4.60 chs., thence N 89° 30° E 12 chs., thence N 25.34 chs. to the place of beginning, and containing 120.39 acres of land, Washington County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
