CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED B. GRABHORN

of Route 1, Box 717, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19895 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 1, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.348 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
13.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12
Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

All of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, in T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W.M., in said County and State, reserving from this conveyance, however, a strip of land 25 feet wide, for road purposes along the entire E side thereof, to be used as a street or public highway, so soon as the street or highway shall publicly and legally declared to be such, from and after which time the said 25 feet is to belong to the public for road purposes, any and all reversionary interest therein to belong to the party of the second part herein.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
