**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That CHAS. I. PATTON**

of **1430 East Park Street, Grants Pass, State of Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Rogue River** a tributary of **irrigation** for the purpose of under Permit No. **20291** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 18, 1951**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre; or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  **$\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**1.4 acres in Lot 5 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 21  
Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W. M.**

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Commencing on the south bank of Rogue River at a point 230 feet East of the NW Corner of Lot 5 in Section 21, Township 36 S., Range 5 W., W.M., Oregon, and being 65 feet south of the NW corner of said Lot 5; thence easterly, following the south bank of said Rogue River about 295 feet to the center of the mouth of Fruitdale Creek (being the creek sometimes designated as Centennial Creek) thence up the center of said creek in a generally southerly and westerly direction to a point directly south of the point of beginning; thence north to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
