CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **GEORGE G. KING**

of P. O. Box 431, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 20679 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 27, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14

Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: beginning at the quarter cor. between Secs. 14 and 15 in T. 36 S., R. 7W., W.M., Ore., thence South along the Section line a distance of 475.5 feet to a point where the section line crosses the North line of the old county road; thence South 61° 30' East along the Northerly line of the old county road 600 feet; thence south 67° 04' East along the Northerly line of the old county road 641 feet to a point on the old established line of the Alice McAllister property as described in Vol. 33 page 124 and Vol. 72, page 247 of the deed records of Josephine county, Oregon; thence 0° 35' East along said old established line 1000 feet to the Northeast corner of said property and which point is also the Northwest corner of a parcel of land formerly owned by J. A. Cookey and described in Vol. 4 page 171 of said deed records; thence North 89° 29' West to the point of beginning, containing 19.6 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
