CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LARRY C. ADAMS

of 2251 Portola Drive, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River a tributary of irrigation for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21173 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South right of way line of a county road being 30 feet south and 140 feet east of the center of section 21 in Township 36 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Oregon thence running East along said right of way line 100 feet; thence South 580 feet to Rogue River; thence Southwesterly along Rogue River 109 feet; thence North to point of beginning, containing 1.4 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
