## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. C. AND C. F. HEAD

of Azalea , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Cow Creek atributary of South Umpque River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 19730 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from July 28. 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the 2 of SW2, Section 28, and NW2 NE2, Section 33, all being within Township 31 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to cne-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.375 c.f.s.,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.6 acres in NEt SW1
9.4 acres in SEt SW1
Section 28
11.9 acres in NW1 NEt
29 3 Section 33
Township 31 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
