**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ESTATE OF FERDINAND LEMCKE

of Route 1, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18003 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 17, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.325 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Andrew Harper D.L.C. No. 41, Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres in Lot 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
5.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Andrew Harper D.L.C. No. 41  
5.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Andrew Harper D.L.C. No. 41  
Section 1  
4.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Andrew Harper D.L.C. No. 41  
8.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Andrew Harper D.L.C. No. 41  
Section 12  
Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Part of the Andrew Harper DLC #41 & part of Sec. 1, T. 1 S. R. 4 W., W. M., Beginning at a stone in center of county road No. 214 distant N. 89° 25' E. 33.15 chs. from where said road crosses the W. line of said Harper DLC and running thence S. 89° 25' W. 1.43 chs., thence N. 9° 35' W. 11.34 chs. to the S. line of the T. G. Naylor DLC; thence 69° 30' E. on the said line 13.30 chs., thence S. 17° 29' W. 9.16 chs. to the center of said road; thence N. 69° 45' W. 6.78 chs. to the place of beg., containing 10 acres more or less being the same tract of land as described in Book 82 at page 222 of Deed Records of Washington Co., Oregon.  
ALSO: Beg. at the SE cor. of DLC of T. G. Naylor T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W.M., and running thence S 4° W. 10.50 chs., thence N. 83° 25' W. 23.66 chs., thence N. 69° 45' W. 2.05 chs. more or less, to the E. line of the land owned at the present date by James Kirby; thence N. 17° 48' E. 9.16 chs. to the S. line of the said T. G. Naylor DLC; thence E. 18.75 chs. to the place of beg., containing 19.89 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
