CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAVID RICH

of Route 4, Box 356, Sherwood , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 20127 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 23, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.298 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL NEL, as projected on Phillip Harris D.L.C. No. 53, Section 32, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres in NEt NEt, as projected on Phillip Harris D.L.C. No. 53

8.4 acres in SW NEt, as projected on Phillip Harris D.L.C. No. 53

13.6 acres in SEt NEt, as projected on Phillip Harris D.L.C. No. 53 Section 32

Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Also: Beg. at a stone in the center of Scholls and Hillsboro Road 9.11 chs. S. 15°21' W from where the center of said road intersects the center of Farmington and Portland Road, being the SE cor. of a tract of land in the NW corner of said Phillip Harris DLC now owned by William Justadt, the said stone being designated as "M" in County Survey No. 1682 and running thence S 15° 21' W in the center of said Scholls Road 36.25 chs. to a stone; thence S 9°26' E 16.61 chs. to a tiling 4 in. in diameter with an iron pipe in the center from which an oak 36 in. in diameter marked C.S.B.T. bears south 13° E 3.05 chs., thence N 84°36' W 22.00 chs., more or less, to the center of Tualatin River; thence up the center of said stream with the meanders thereof 40.00 chains, more or less, to a point which bears N 72° 38' W from the place of beginning, described above; thence S 72°38' E 15.00 chs., more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 131.07 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
