CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CORNELIUS W. MARTIN and LAURENCE B. DENNIS

of Edelweiss Inn, Joseph _____, State of Oregon _____, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring and Spring Creek a tributary of Wallowa River _____ for the purpose of domestic use including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 5349 _____ of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 2, 1922;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1125 cubic foot per second for domestic purposes throughout the year; and 0.1875 cubic foot per second for domestic use including irrigation of lawn and garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area, said diversion of 0.1875 cubic foot per second being limited to the irrigation season from May 1 to October 1 of each year as fixed by Decree of the Circuit Court of Wallowa County, Oregon, entered Jan. 20, 1919 in the Wallowa River adjudication proceedings;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 4, 1948, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., and supersedes Certificate of Water Right issued to J. A. Hopkins and recorded at Page 7773, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
