## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That H. W. DRENKLE, 3350 Coolidge Avenue,

of Oakland, State of California, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Deadman Creek

for the purpose of irrigation of 29.85 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 233; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from November 28, 1876;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  $3/4$  acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and  $1/2$  acre foot per acre during any 30-day period after June 1st of each year; and  $2\ 1/2$  acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed  $1/40$  cubic foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

29.85 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 15,  
T. 39 S., R. 20 E., W.M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use of water approved by an Order of the State Engineer entered April 20, 1934, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., and said certificate, together with certificate recorded at Page 20228, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate of Water Right heretofore issued to H. W. Drenkle and recorded at Page 5235, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
