## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

TURNER MEMORIAL HOME

of Turner

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of

North Santiam River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion. County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 351, that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1909;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one—sightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.8 acres in S1 SW1 NW1 6.2 acres in N2 NW1 SW1 Section 28,
T. 8 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

NOTE: To compensate for losses between the point of diversion from the Gardner-Bennett Canal Waste-way or the North Santiam River to the place of use, an additional amount not exceeding 10% is allowed.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an Order of the State Engineer entered March 16, 1950, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, 0. C. L. A.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
