## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES W. RICHARDSON

of Route 1, Dayton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Palmer Creek and an unnamed stream

has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from May 11, 1936

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.345 cubic foot per second, being 0.225 c.f.s. from Palmer Creek and 0.12 c.f.s. from unnamed stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the from unnamed stream: NE 1 NE 1, as projected within John Thessing D.L.C. No. 51; from Palmer Creek: NW 1 NE 1, as projected within John Thessing D.L.C. No. 51, all being within Section 8, Township 5 South, Range 3 West. W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

. 4.4 acres in NW4 NE4, as projected on D.L.C. No. 51. 23.2 acres in NE4 NE4, as projected on D.L.C. No. 51. Section 8. Township 5 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
