**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is To Certify, That** H. L. STIFF, JR.

of Route 3, Box 870, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation, fire protection and general farm use under Permit No. 16680 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 23, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second, being 0.14 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.01 c.f.s. for fire protection and general farm use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, Township 8 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within A. R. Stoughton D.L.C. No. 64  
7.5 acres in Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
1.8 acres in Lot 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
0.1 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within A. R. Stoughton D.L.C. No. 64  
Section 12  
Township 8 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 9.47 chains South 8° West and 33 links North 52° 30' west of the point where the West line of the Donation Land Claim of A. R. Stoughton and wife intersects the South boundary of the North half of Section 12 in Township 8 South of Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon, and from thence running North 52° 30' West 6.16 chains; thence North 7° East 12.44 chains; thence North 78° 20' West 1.73 chains to the middle of the county road leading from Salem to Hall's Ferry; thence South 21° 15' West along the center of said county road, 4.52 chains to the most Easterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to F. Kenneth Power and Catherine E. Power, his wife, by instrument recorded February 18, 1941 in Vol. 255, at Page 491, Deed Records for said county and state; thence Southerly following the line of said land of Power, South 19° 15' West 2.94 chains, South 35° 35' W. 3.749 chains, North 68° 33' West to the Willamette River, thence Southerly, following the meanderings of the Right Bank of said River up stream, 10.50 chains to the mouth of Spring branch; thence following the meanderings of the middle of said Spring branch up stream, South 65° 40' East 2.25 chains; South 79° East 1.55 chains; North 81° 47' East 1.01 chains; South 48° 25' East

2.85 chains; thence South 61° 28' East 2.96 chains; South 28° 25' East 2.75 chains; thence South 22° 18' East 1.33 chains; South 30° 12' East 2.22 chains; South 51° 30' East 1.84 chains; South 70° 55' East 65 links to an iron rod set at a point 14.10 chains South 8° East from the place of beginning, thence North 8° West 14.10 chains to the place of beginning and containing 18.53 acres of land, more or less, excepting therefrom 1.35 acres of land deeded to the Oregon Electric Railway Company, which deed is of record at Page 104, Vol. 119, of the Deed Records for Marion County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
