CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM JOY SMITH

of 611 Corbett Building, Portland 1: , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three springs, tributary of an unnamed stream,

a tributary of coursels Biver for the purpose of

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation, domestic use for one family, and fish culture under Permit No. 15311 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.113 c.f.s. for irrigation; 0.01 c.f.s. from spring #1 for domestic use, and 0.377 c.f.s. for fish culture,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW NE Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 2 East, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.0 acres in NW4 NE4
Section 25

Township 1 North, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
The following described property situated in the County of Multnomah, and State of Oregon; A part of the Hiram Barker Donation Land Claim described as follows: Beginning at the quarter section corner in the North Line of Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence South 89 52' 30" East along the North Line of said Section 25, 140.95 feet; thence South 0 11' West 2030.29 feet to the North line of the right of way of the 0.W.R. & N.,Co., thence Westerly along the North line of said right of way to the North and South center line of said Section 25; thence North 0 20' 50" East, 2015.76 feet to the place of beginning, being the West half of the West one—third of that portion of the Northeast quarter of said Section 25, lying North of the right of way of the 0.W.R. & N. Co;
Together with a right of way for road purposes over the North 11 feet of Lot 2, Elock 2, in SPRINGWATER ACREAGE in Multanmah County, Oregon, "tending from the West line of the premises first above described to the county road on the West side of said Springwater Acreage. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
