CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARTHUR G. PLANT

of 1200 N. Oregon Street, Ontario , State of Oregon . , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Snake River a tributary of Columbia River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 15679 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 21, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 ($Nil_{\frac{1}{4}}^{-1}$ $Nil_{\frac{1}{4}}^{-1}$), Section 3, Township 18 South, Range 47 East, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-twentieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.8 acres in Lot 1 (NW4 NW4)
Section 3

Township 18 South, Range 47 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at a point 529.9 ft. east and 797 ft. north from the southwest corner of Lot 1, Section 3, Township 18 South, Range 17 East, W.M., thence north 200 ft., thence south 82 degrees East 130.9 ft. thence South 72 degrees East 130.6 ft., thence South 31 degrees East 189.6 ft., thence south 28 degrees West 340.1 ft., to the South boundary of the Old Oregon Trail Highway; thence North 40 degrees and 20 minutes West along said highway to the point of beginning, containing 5.13 acres more or less; excepting 1.27 acres already deeded to the State Highway Commission for the Old Oregon Trail Highway, leaving 3.86 acres more or less, all of said property being in Malheur County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
