**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** JOHN B. EHLER

of Route 3, Box 1037, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19694 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 6, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.088 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Phillip Harris D.L.C. No. 53, Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 4.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 53  
Section 28
- 2.1 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 53  
Section 29
- 0.2 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 53  
Section 33

Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appriator as follows:

by running  
A certain tract of ground which is reached from the N.W. corner of Phillips Harris D.L.C. south 71 deg. 38' E. 9.20 chains to a stone in center of County Road No. 405 and South 16 deg. 34' W 6.13 chs. to a stone set for beginning point of Road 405 for a beginning point of tract hereby conveyed and running thence S 16 degrees 04' W 9.13 chs. to a stone; thence north 70 degrees 31' W 11.28 chs more or less to the center of Tualatin River; thence up the center of said river 7.16 chs more or less to the center of Farmington Road; thence south 70 degrees 25' E 3.35 chs to angle in said road; thence S 83 degrees 48' E 9.39 chs to the place of beginning containing 10.47 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
