## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That RAYHOND H. AND RALPH E. BARKER

of Route 2, Payette , State of Idaho , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Shopards Gulch drainage canal a tributary of Snake River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17512 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 24, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.375 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE NW1, Section 14, Township 16 South, Range 17

East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-twentieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1½ acre feet per acre for sach acre irrigated in any 30-day period after June 1st and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any irrigation season, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.375 cubic feet per second,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.4 acres in SW2 NW2
39.6 acres in NW4 SW2
19.5 acres in W2 SW2 SW2
Section 11
37.4 acres in NE2 SE2
33.0 acres in SE2 SE4
Section 10
Township 16 South, Range 47 East, W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriators as follows:

All that portion of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter lying south of Snake River; the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter; and the north 35 acres of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 10; and all that part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter lying south of Snake River; the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter; and the west half of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 11; all lying and being in township 16 south, range 17 east of Willamette Meridian in Malheur County, Oregon;
