## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That JOHN WALCH

of lake Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lost Creek, a tributary of S. Fork Little Butte,

a tributary of Little Butte Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 19724 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from July 25, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.90 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE SEA, Section 21, Township 37 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed be acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

35.5 acres in SW4 SW4
Section 3
10.1 acres in NE2 NE4
6.9 acres in SE4 NE4
Section 9
39.6 acres in NW2 NW4
23.9 acres in SW4 NW4
Section 10

Township 37 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The South half of the Northeast quarter of Section 9, and a parcel of land 31 rods in width and 80 rods in length off the South side of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 9; and the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 10, and the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 3, all lying and being situated in Township 37 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian; together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, appurtenances, ditch rights and water rights appurtenant thereto or in any manner appertaining. The Deed Records of Jackson County show that the appropriator owns the  $\mathbb{W}^1_2$  of the  $\mathbb{S}\mathbb{W}^1_4$  of Section 3, the  $\mathbb{W}^1_3$  of the  $\mathbb{N}\mathbb{W}^1_4$  of Section 10 and the  $\mathbb{N}\mathbb{E}^1_4$  of Section 9 all in T 37 S, R 2 E, W.M., in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
