CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROY J. MOORE

of Route 1, Box 171-A, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the purpose of supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 19893 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 31, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4
Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon; thence East 468 feet; thence S. 15 degrees 30' E. along the Westerly line of County Road 845.12 feet more or less to a true point of beginning; thence West 300 feet more or less to the West bank of Pleasant Creek; thence South along the West bank of Pleasant Creek 500 feet more or less to the half section line; thence East 375 feet more or less to the Westerly line of the County Road; thence N. 15 degrees 30' W. along Westerly line of County Road 520 feet more or less to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
