CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** LOUIS SPOUSTA

of Route 1, Box 663, Tigard, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20617 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 6, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.134 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.10 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
24.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 16

Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Washington, State of Oregon, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the section line 2.77 chains east of the quarter section corner of the north boundary of Section 16, Township 2 South of Range 1 West of the W.M., Washington County, Oregon, running thence West on Section line 13.49 chains to a point on the section line; thence south parallel with the west boundary of said Section 16, 66.70 chains to the middle channel of the Tualatin River; thence down said channel to a point due south to the beginning corner; thence north 80 chains to the place of beginning, containing 100 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
