This Is to Certify, That GLAHENCE E. AND MARIE K. HAINES

of Route 2, Box 1154, Beaverton , State of , has made proof Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hock Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 20897 of the "te Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 6, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ().Olf cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEA SEA, as projected within Mr. Bennet D.L.C. No. 17, Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in SE SW1, as projected within Wm. Bennet D.L.C. No. 47 Section 35

Township I North, Range 2 West, W. M. 2.6 acres in IE NW1, as projected within Mm. Bennet D.L.C. No. 10 Section 2

Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M. Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by

appropriator as follows: The south half of lot 1, Orence Acres, being a portion of the lot lying south of the

center line of Rock Creek (also known as Dawson Creek) as Shown on the duly recorded map and plat thereof.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
