CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPH HUCER

of 1118 Center Street, Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wesenger Creek

a tributary of Beaverton Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 20917 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from December 20, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.068 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NEL SWL, as projected within Wm. Hall D.L.C. No.

LL, Section 10, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. W.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre fest per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.4 acres in NE 3 SW as projected within Wm. Hall D.L.C. No. 144 Section 10

Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Lots 77, 78 and G of Steel's Addition to the city of Beaverton, excepting that portion conveyed to School District No. 48 by deed as recorded in volume 281, page 382 of Washington County, Oregon, Deed Records.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
