**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **KATHERYN HANLEY HEFFERNAN**

of Route 2, Box 401, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of seepage and reservoir constructed under App. No. R-25886, Per. No. R-1166 a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20317 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within David Clinton D.L.C. No. 68, Section 21, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1166,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within David Clinton D.L.C. No. 68  
0.5 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within David Clinton D.L.C. No. 68  
Section 21

Township 37 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a stake on the West boundary line of D.L.C. No. 67 in Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, situated 39.25 chains South of the Northwest Corner of said claim, thence East 43.30 chains to the East Boundary line of D.L.C. No. 68, thence South along said line 25.10 chains to the Southwest corner of D.L.C. No. 69, thence East 1.67 chains to a corner of said claim, thence South along the East boundary line of said D.L.C. No. 68 13.62 chains to a stake, thence West 45.00 chains to the West boundary line of D.L.C. No. 67, thence North along said line 38.73 chains to the place of beginning, containing 169.95 acres, more or less, being parts of D.L.C.s No. 67 and 68 in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
