CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. E. TORPEN

of 2118 Bertha-Beaverton Hwy., Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed creek, tributary of Beaverton Creek, tributary of Rock Creek and Tualatin River, to be appropriated under Application No. 26783, Permit No. 21012,

for the purposes of irrigation,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1321 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 15, 1952,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-said, shall not exceed 1/2 acre-foot.

The reservoir is located in Section 14, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, T11 South, R1 West, W. M.
