**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ROBERT GEINGER AND RUBY GEINGER

of Courtrock, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek a tributary of North Fork John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 12 acres of land under Permit No. 2424 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25,  
T. 10 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

**NOTE:** This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 11, 1927, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and to supersede certificate of water right heretofore issued to A. J. Wright and recorded at Page 2145, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates and on Pages 475-476, Volume C, Grant County Book of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
