**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That JOHN BOHNERT and EDYTH BOHNERT**

of Route 1, Box 20, Central Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 57.3 acres of land under Permit No. 2526 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 1, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.72 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.10 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 69 Ac. Trsf. Sp. Or Vol 11 p. 36  
5.29 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 529 - - - - - 11 p. 36  
29.91 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
Section 34,  
T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 4, 1952, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530 and said certificate supercedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to L. A. Salade, and recorded at Page 2211, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
