CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM R. PEYRON

of Baker, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, a tributary of Snake River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 40 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40th of one cubic foot per second per acre,

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

- 15.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 22.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- Section 36
- T. 8 S., R. 40 E., W. M.
  
- 2.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$
- Section 1,
- T. 9 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water approved by an Order of the State Engineer entered May 6, 1949, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and said certificate supercedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Frances E. Reynolds, and recorded at Page 4427, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
