CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That S. L. CARLI

of route 1, Box 80, Clackamas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream & Reservoir constructed under App. No. R-26696, Per. No. R-1289 a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of

irrigation and supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 20899 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 7, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1289; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION
7.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.2 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point 236.2 feet East from the section quarter corner on the line between Sections 10 and 15 in T. 2 S., R. 2 E., of the W.M. running thence South 896.9 feet; thence South 58 deg. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' West 102.7 feet; thence South 76 deg. 15' West 158.4 feet; thence South 5 deg. 20' West 65.7 feet; thence North 66 deg 07' West 75 feet; thence South 77 deg. 56' West 99.5 feet; thence North 79 deg. 45' West 87.2 feet; thence South 89 deg. 50' West 320 feet; to the Southeast corner of a tract conveyed to Andrew C. Kelnhofer by deed recorded July 8, 1916, Book 143, Page 400 Deed Records; thence North 84 deg. 54' West 103.56 ft. thence North 77 deg. 15' West 138.42 feet; thence South 60 deg. 40' West 195 feet to the right bank of the Clackamas River; thence up stream following the meander of the river to the line between Lots 2 and 3 of said Section 15; thence North along said line to the Northwest corner of said Lot 2; thence East along the North line of said Lot 2 to the Southwest corner of the land conveyed to A.C. and A.J. Kelnhofer by deed recorded in Book 143 page 399, Records of Clackamas County thence North along the W. line of said tract 579.9 feet thence N. 0 deg. 15' East 736.5 feet; thence West 143.9 feet to the place of beginning; save and except a right of way 15 feet

wide as now used for ingress and egress to property owned by the grantor, said right of way being along the northerly boundary of the property herein conveyed.
