**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **KENNETH DISRUDE**

of **Route 1, Box 475, Ashland**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **an unnamed gulch, tributary of Neal Creek** a tributary of **Bear Creek** for the purpose of **irrigation** under Permit No. **18927** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 9, 1949**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.05 cubic foot per second,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 24, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **1 $\frac{1}{2}$**  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$**   
 Section 24,  
 Township 39 South, Range 1 East, W. M.  
 1.0 acre in **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
 Section 19  
 Township 39 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Donation Land Claim No. 59 in Township 39 South of Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon, which point is 1590.70 feet south of the northwest corner of said Claim; thence north 62° 22' east 380.66 feet to the center line of State Highway No. 66; thence along said center line south 52° 16' east 225.41 feet; thence south 59° 06' west 600.76 feet to said west line of Claim No. 59; thence north along said line 270 feet to the point of beginning. EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion of the above described premises situated in public streets or roads.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
