CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLAUDE D. TRIMBLE

of 121 S.W. 1st Street, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19886 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 20, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 14
Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 14 in Township 36 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian and running East 1122 feet to a U. S. Marker; thence running along the Easterly line of a Market Road South 18° West 350 feet to the true point of beginning of this description; thence running North 72° West 630 feet; thence South 18° West 250 feet; thence South 72° East 220 feet to the Westerly bank of Rogue River; thence along said bank on a calculated course of North 18° East 250 feet; thence North 72° West 220 feet to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
