CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. E. AND LUELLE M. RASMUSSEN

of Monroe, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hammer Creek and Gap Creek, tributary of Muddy Creek, a tributary of Mary's River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 12927 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 10, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second, being 0.14 c.f.s. from Hammer Creek, and 0.18 c.f.s. from Gap Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located ~~in the~~ in the From Hammer Creek: In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Hammer D.L.C. No. 48, Section 27; From Gap Creek: In the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Hammer D.L.C. No. 48, Section 34, all being within Township 14 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

From Hammer Creek:

0.8 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
8.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.6 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
3.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

From Gap Creek:

11.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 27
3.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
